

FEATURES OF THE SÜDTIROL ALTO ADIGE GUEST PASS - MOBILCARD

The "Südtirol Alto Adige Guest Pass - Mobilcard" is offered to guests as a special inclusive service by the host.

It is available to all holiday guests of those accommodation providers that are members of the local tourism organisation, as it is financed by membership fees and service revenues. The Südtirol Alto Adige Guest Pass promotes sustainable mobility and the use of public transport and contributes to reducing the negative impact of private motorised transport.

The Südtirol Alto Adige Guest Pass

- is issued to all guests over 6 years of age
- is to be provided with the name of the guest and the length of stay on the reverse side
- is valid for the period of the stay from 00:00 on the day of arrival until 23:59 on the day of departure
- is valid for the entire duration of your stay a second ticket is issued for a holiday period of more than 7 days
- must be validated at the beginning of each bus journey (for train journeys before boarding), but without indicating the destination
- is not for sale
- may not be used by the owners and/or employees of the accommodation facility
- permits the holder to unlimited use of the entire local public transport system (ÖPNV) in the "südtirolmobil-Verbundgebiet":
 - Local buses (city, intercity & city buses), PostBus Schweiz (between Mals/Malles Venosta and Müstair)
 - Regional trains in South Tyrol: Brenner/Brennero to Trient/Trento and Mals/Malles to Innichen/San Candido or Vierschach/Versciaco, Rittner/Renon narrow-gauge railway
 - Cable cars: Mühlbach-Meransen/Rio di Pusteria-Maranza, Burgstall-Vöran/Postal-Verano, Vilpian-Mölten/Vilpiano-Meltina, Bozen-Kohlern/Bolzano-Colle, Bozen-Ritten/Bolzano-Renon, funicular to the Mendel/Mendola

Excluded are: Nightliner, long-distance trains (e.g. EC and Intercity trains, Railjet, Frecce, Italo), as well as the following Alpine lines in the summer months: 439, 440, 442 & 444. An additional ticket must be bought for bicycles, dogs and other types of animals!

New ticketing system

• Validation Südtirol Alto Adige Guest Pass: Public transport buses are currently being gradually equipped with new technology for ticketing and passenger information. The new validators can be used to a limited extent during this introductory period.

Be careful when handling and storing the tickets. The magnetic strips are unfortunately very sensitive, so please protect them from bending and demagnetisation! Possible sources of demagnetisation include: Mobile phones, magnetic closures, POS devices, copying machine etc. Please store the ticket away from the devices listed.

If the ticket is damaged with a magnetic stripe, it will be stamped by the validation machine on the bus/train with **"illeg./Unleserl." + date and time**. The passenger can still continue the journey for the entire day, but must then exchange the card at their place of accommodation.
